SAFETY	 This regatta is a DBNSW sanctioned event and Kempsey Macleay Dragon Boat Club will appoint a Regatta Safety Officer to advise the Chief Race Official on all matters relating to the safety of participants, officials, spectators and others present at the venue. The name of the Regatta Safety Officer will be advised at the Team Captains' briefing at the commencement of racing. Adherence to safety-related instructions from either the Regatta Safety Officer or the Chief Race Official is mandatory Nothing in (1) above: A. removes the responsibility for crews to do all in their power to ensure the safety of participants, officials, spectators and others present at the venue - safety is everyone's responsibility; and B. affects the right of Clubs and Steerers to adopt a more risk adverse approach to specific situations, nor does it affect the responsibilities of the sweep for the safety of his or her crew.
